

# Results of the Yazaki Social & Environmental Report 2006 Survey

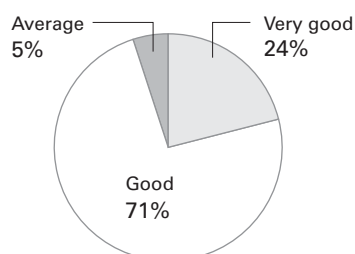
We received forty responses to the survey concerning the Yazaki Social & Environmental Report 2006 issued in September 2006.

We would like to thank all of the readers who responded to the survey and to report on the survey results.

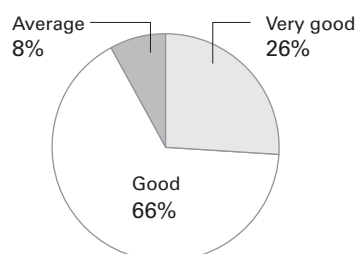
The results of the survey have been summarized below.

## Q1 | What was your impression of the Yazaki Social & Environmental Report 2006?

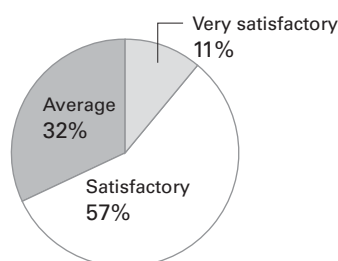
1) Yazaki's social contribution initiatives



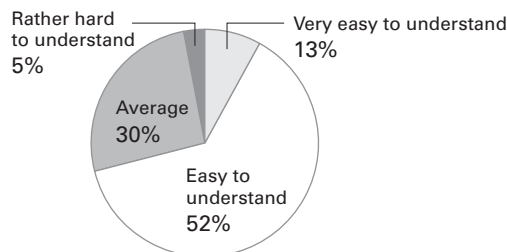
2) Yazaki's environmental initiatives



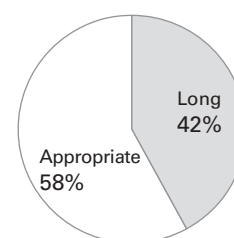
